1) What causes a dog's urine to yellow the grass?

- Yellow spots can be caused by having excessive nitrogen in the urine and alkaline urine.
- Poor diet, medication or poor drinking water.
- **Not every dog's urine burns the grass.** In households with multiple dogs you need to determine which dog is actually the culprit. Giving GrassSaver to a dog whose urine is not burning the grass, may cause the dog's urine **to** burn the grass.

2) How do I solve the problem?

- Feed your dog the GrassSaver Supplement of choice. The ingredients work synergistically to help address alkaline and excessive nitrogen in the urine.
- Saturate the urinated spots with water immediately.

- Re-seed your yellow spots only after you have the situation under control. NaturVet Yellow to Green colors the yellow spots, making them less noticeable
